



**THIS FORM MUST ACCOMPANY ALL HORSES SHIPPING
INTO THE PRINCETON SHOW JUMPING FACILITY**

Required for ALL horses entering the PSJ Show grounds:

1. A current negative coggins. Within the past 12 months.
2. Signed statement of health signed by a veterinarian or barn manager with documentation of horse's temperatures 72 hours prior to arrival at PSJ.
3. Proof of vaccination for each horse against EHV-1 and EHV-4 no more than 6 months, and no less than 7 days upon arrival.

By signing this letter I hereby certify that none of the horses in my care have been in direct contact or stabled with any horses that have received a positive test for the EHV-1 virus. I also certify that none of the horses in my care have been housed in any current quarantined facility. I also certify that I will continue to follow all biosecurity precautions set forth by Princeton Show Jumping.

Princeton Show Jumping is asking all equestrians to enact biosecurity protocols and be proactive and responsible for their horses, including daily temperature charts. You should be able to document your horses' normal temperature before arrival. Please do not ship horses with elevated temperatures. It is recommended that you establish a log of temperatures taken at least twice daily. If there is an elevated temperature for more than a 24 hour period, please consult your local veterinarian immediately.

Do not bring any horses with elevated temperatures or horses that come from quarantined farms onto Princeton Show Jumping property.
